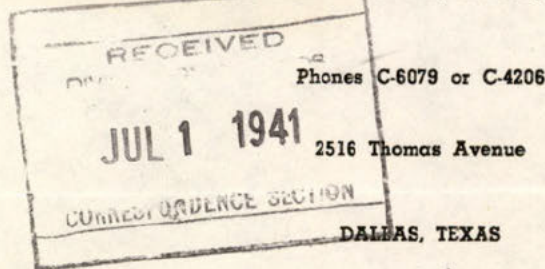

We appeal to you as The Department of Justice to at once call for a re-opening of this case for investigation.

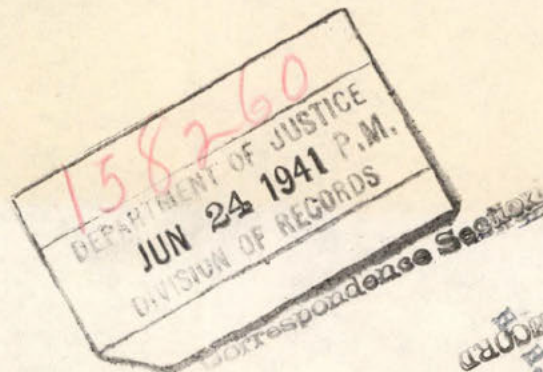
