5. DETAILS On October 22, 1957 at approximately 1:30 am, ROGER HAMILTON was taken from his residence and shot once in the head. HAMILTON died as a result of his injuries. On Wednesday, October 14, 2009, ABI Corporal [REDACTED] interviewed GEORGE R. MCCURDY at the Capital Rehab Center in Montgomery, Alabama. MCCURDY owned the property on which the HAMILTON family's residence was located. According to the original report, it was MCCURDY who contacted the Lowndes County Sheriff's Department after being notified by BEATRICE HAMILTON that her son had been shot. At the time of the interview, MCCURDY was recovering from a mild stroke. MCCURDY advised that on the night that HAMILTON was shot, he had been in bed asleep with his wife when he heard a loud knock at the door. MCCURDY advised that he was told that ROGER HAMILTON had been shot and that he then called the Sheriff's Department. While being questioned, MCCURDY advised that he was not present when HAMILTON was shot and that he did not know for sure who shot HAMILTON. MCCURDY advised that he had heard rumors as to who had been involved in the killing of HAMILTON, but MCCURDY stated that "if I'd known anything then they would have killed me and if I knew anything now they would still kill me." MCCURDY appeared to be genuinely frightened of those involved while speaking with Corporal [REDACTED]. MCCURDY repeatedly stated that he lived alone and that Corporal [REDACTED] would not be able to protect him. MCCURDY would not provide a written or audio statement. Attachment: Interview Sheet
