

Dear Madam:

We have your letter of July 20, 1941, addressed to the President and by him referred to this Department, alleging that your son, William Fowler, was shot by someone.

The protection of one's person is a duty coming under the jurisdiction of the state and local law enforcement officers. The Federal Government, therefore, has no authority to intervene in such cases. We can only suggest, if you have not already done so, that you take up the matter with the department of police in your city.
